

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO CHIDDINGLY PARISH BONFIRE SOCIETY'S
FIRESITE.
(ENTRY CONTRACT)**

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

These terms and conditions of entry apply to all persons entering the Chiddingly Parish Bonfire Society Firesite on the grounds of Peke's Manor, Nash St, Golden Cross, BN27 4AD. These Conditions are issued by Chiddingly Parish Bonfire Society (the "**Society**" or "**we**"). By entering the firesite you are deemed to have accepted these Conditions. Acceptance of these Conditions will result in a legally binding contract between you and the society which include the terms of the licence which we have granted to you to enter the firesite.

If a provision in these Conditions conflicts with a provision in any property-specific Conditions, the terms of these Conditions herein shall prevail.

It is your responsibility to familiarise yourself with these Conditions.

- These Conditions may also be referred to as the Entry Contract.
- These Conditions apply to all persons entering the firesite.
- If you do not understand or have any questions relating to these Conditions or any Special Conditions you should contact the society without delay for clarification.
- Entry to the firesite shall be by the purchase, and wearing of a 2024 CPBS firesite wristband, and at the society's discretion. We reserve the right to refuse entry to or expel any person from the firesite in accordance with these Conditions.
- Children under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by an adult. Proof of age may be requested and, if so, must be provided.
- No refund shall be given in respect of any unused wristband.
- You must wear & show your wristband to the gate crew on demand. If you fail to bring and wear your wristband, entry to the firesite will be denied.
- We accept no responsibility for lost or stolen wristbands. We are not obliged to replace lost or stolen wristbands.
- Your wristband gains entrance to the public enclosure only and will restrict access to certain areas of the firesite including the member's enclosure and all buildings.
- We reserve the right in our absolute discretion at any time and without prior notice to refuse admission to or expel and/or ban any Attendee who, in our opinion has or is likely to commit a criminal offence or otherwise do anything which is unlawful; and/or behaves or is likely to behave in an unacceptable or unruly manner or in a manner likely to cause offence to other Attendees.
- You must follow the reasonable written and/or verbal instructions of safety stewards, marshals and officials and the emergency services present at the firesite at all times.
- The following items must not be brought onto the firesite: drugs, knives, fireworks, smoke canisters, air-horns, glass bottles or other glass or similarly breakable containers, poles and any other article that might be used as a weapon and/or may in our reasonable opinion compromise the safety of any person present. We shall be entitled to refuse entry to the firesite, any Attendee with such items in their possession.
- Furthermore; drones, kites and aerial systems that have not been expressly authorised by the society in advance; any behaviour which may disrupt or impair the experience of other Attendees; climbing fences, stands or any other structures or buildings; obstruction of access ways, exits, entrances, and similar places and damaging or defacing Peke's Manor or Society property are all prohibited.
- Sparklers may be brought onto the firesite for use in the public enclosure; but the society accepts no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or injury caused.

- Only those Attendees who have been given express prior permission by the society to trade, advertise, distribute leaflets or conduct any other commercial or promotional activities on the firesite may do so. Trading, advertising, leafleting and commercial or promotional activities by all other Attendees is strictly prohibited.
- All Attendees are reminded that the society's firesite *may* be given coverage on television, radio and in print and various other forms of media. By entering the firesite, you accept (for yourself and on behalf of any children in your care) that you/they may appear in such coverage, which may also include printed or electronic material used for the promotion by and of the society. Accordingly, you shall have no right to or demand any payment in respect of you or your children's inclusion in any such coverage.
- Dogs (other than assistance dogs) are not permitted anywhere on the society's firesite, except for those required for disabled assistance.
- Any property brought onto the firesite by an Attendee remains at all times at the entire risk of the Attendee. We will not be liable for any loss, injury or damage, howsoever caused to any Attendee or their property. However, nothing in these Conditions shall limit or exclude our liability in respect of death or personal injury caused by our negligence or fraudulent act or omission or for any other liability which cannot by law be excluded or limited.
- If you leave any property at the firesite, we will endeavour to retain such property for a period of three weeks, during which time you may contact us to arrange a time to collect it. Any property left unclaimed at the firesite for longer than this period will be disposed of.
- By purchase of a firesite wristband, you accept that it may be necessary for us to cancel some aspects of our event, or the entirety of our event at short notice as a result of any events beyond our reasonable control such as, but not limited to, war, acts of terrorism, civil disturbance, any order or act of a governmental or regulatory body, fire, flood, severe or adverse weather conditions, disease, pandemic, epidemic or other circumstances concerning the healthcare or well-being of humans. In which case, the society will do its utmost to reschedule within 7 days or offer a 50% refund on the exchange of any purchased wristband.
- In the event of an emergency all relevant areas must be evacuated. Please listen to announcements, and the instructions of marshals in high vis vests. Any emergency should be reported immediately to a marshal or steward at the firesite.

Attendees must accept that, by its very nature, attending this event is not without risk. Attendees must therefore remain vigilant and always exercise a reasonable degree of caution and care for themselves and those around them.

We reserve the right to amend and supplement these Conditions by publishing additional and supplementary conditions and guidelines from time to time ("Variations"). Variations will be effective to vary these Conditions on such basis as we may stipulate and may be of permanent or temporary effect. We will take reasonable steps to bring any Variations to your attention.
